### English

**<u>Recounts</u>**: We will be writing recounts of our trips to the church and Florence Nightingale Museum using adverbs of time. <u>**Letters**</u>: We will be writing letters from Mary Seacole to her family back home sharing her experiences of the Crimean war. <u>**Diary**</u>: We will be writing diary entries as Florence Nightingale sharing our thoughts and feelings about the conditions of the hospital in Scutari.

**<u>Grammar</u>**: The year 2 grammar skills we will be learning include:

- Contractions
- Expanded noun phrases
- Subordinating and coordinating conjunctions
- Punctuation (full stops, question marks, explanation marks and apostrophes)

Please discuss these grammatical features with your children when they are reading and encourage them to check their writing for common mistakes.

This half-term we will be delving into the past and discovering more about the inspirational lives of Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale. We will launch the topic with a fascinating trip to the Florence Nightingale Museum at St Thomas' Hospital and meet Florence herself!
