A lamb is a baby sheep.

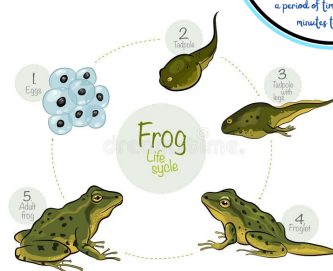
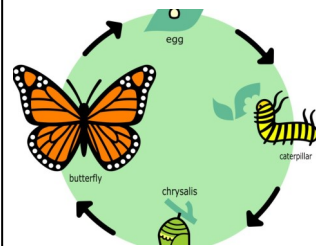
