#### Hillcross Whole School Topic -Family Team Competition

The whole school topic has begun! The children have already enjoyed the launch assembly and our 'Wear it Wild!' event. We are proud to announce we have raised £233 through our voluntary contribution buckets and this money will be going to the World Wildlife Fund (WWF). We are looking forward to sharing our work each week across the whole school community through our Twitter page and Year group website pages.

Every year, during the Whole School Topic, we hold a family competition. This year however we have decided to mix things up a little! Our competition this year will be a Year group competition where children, staff and family members all join together to develop an area of the school grounds. Through our topic focus on sustainability and how we can help and protect our planet, we also wanted to focus on our own school environment. We are so incredibly lucky to have such wonderful grounds to learn in and we want to develop these even more! Each Year Group has been assigned a key area of our environment to evaluate and improve. The children will be fully involved in planning and developing these areas to create a more natural, environmentally and wildlife friendly area. With a real focus on upcycling, naturally resourcing and planting, each area will then be developed by the children, staff and families.

#### The Planning stage

This week the children and staff will be researching, planning and designing their areas. In the week Beginning 19th June, next week, we will be inviting families into school at agreed times, see below, to look at the children's designs and ideas. We will require your help and input to decide how we can act on our ideas and will draw on your knowledge, skills and contacts to make the plans a reality! We will develop a wish list of resources and materials that parents and school will need to source and gather ready for week 4.



Winners will be announced at our Whole School Topic Finale, Monday 17th July. The judges will be our ECO Committee members, Almaz Ennis- Morris (ECO schools lead), Sharon Furlong, (ECO schools lead governor) and Lisa Francis. The judging will look at how eco-friendly the areas are, how sustainable and durable the new items are and how much has been recycled and reused to create and develop these spaces. The winning Year group will win a financial contribution to further develop their area, along with a year group celebration event.
