



YEAR 6 CURRICULUM INFORMATION

English

Persuasion: We will evaluate the purpose and importance of persuasion; linking our points together and using persuasive language techniques to deliberately influence the reader through our persuasive letters.

Narrative: We will evaluate how authors develop tension; use dialogue to enhance a story; and use a variety of sentence structures and punctuation to influence the reader and use these techniques to write an amazing story based around Game, Set and Match!

Grammar: The year 6 grammar skills we will be learning include:

- Use of the passive to affect the presentation of information within a sentence.
- Use of a wider range of cohesive devises.
- Use of descriptive techniques to engage the reader.
- Accurate use of inverted commas, semi colons, colons, dashes and hyphens.

Please discuss these grammatical features with your children when they are reading and encourage them to check their writing for common mistakes.



Topic Overview

This half-term we will be Wombleing through a study of Wimbledon. We will be investigate the local area; understanding how the science of friction affects our everyday lives, and improving our drawing techniques to show an action.
