YEAR 4 CURRICULUM INFORMATION



English

<u>Persuasive writing</u> - we will be using our knowledge of persuasive language to try and persuade the teachers to let us go on more school trips.

<u>Explanation texts</u> - we will be using our learning in Geography to write an explanation text about volcanoes in the form of a booklet.

<u>Grammar</u> - the grammar skills which we will be learning, include:

- Simple present tense.
- Time sequencing adverbs. E.g., After, later, finally.
- Reinforcing and opposing adverbs to link ideas between sentences and paragraphs. E.g., In addition to, because of this.
- Using a range of subordinating conjunctions.
- Expanding noun phrases by using adjectives and prepositions. E.g.,
 Millions of years later, the rocks surrounding the skeleton rises to the Earth's surface.
- The grammatical difference between plural and possessive -s. E.g., The dogs were playing in the garden vs. The boy's dog was playing in the garden. ▶ Plural (more than one) possession (possessive apostrophe)
- Punctuate all sentences appropriately. Non-negotiable: capital

Maths

Division

We will be learning about short division methods and how to divide a 2, 3 or 4 digit number by a 1 digit number.

Measuring and Fractions

Ordering, comparing & rounding decimals. Converting units of measure. E.g., 15.4cm = 154mm = 0.154m (x÷10 & 100). Fractions, percentages and decimal equivalents. E.g., $\frac{1}{2} = 50\% = 0.5$.

Mental Maths strategies

Adding 9, 99, 999 by compensating. E.g., 24 + 9 (24+10-1). By the end of Year 4 the expectation is that children know all their times tables.



Topic Overview

During this topic we will be investigating and exploring about Rivers, lakes, minerals, volcanoes — Earth! We will be researching and understanding the physical geography and its effect on the distribution of natural resources. In Science we will be investigating the effects of temperature on materials, making observations and drawing conclusions from the results. Finally, in DT we will be using a range of tools and materials to create mechanical systems.

Our topic this half term is Mother Earth
