English

Non-Fiction:

This term, we will be looking at information texts about the animals that we will be learning about. We will explore the features of non-fiction books.

We are FANTASTIC writers!:

The children will be enhancing their writing journey following the FANTASTIC writing approach. By developing this vocabulary rich lesson structure they will be adapting stories using their own amazing sentences.

Grammar: The year 1 skills we will be developing include:

- Using capital letters for proper nouns
- Using 'and' and 'because' to extend their writing.
- Use of adjectives to describe

Maths


Addition and Subtraction

This term in maths we will:

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving 2 addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero
- Use a variety of methods: counting on in our heads; number lines;
- Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes

Topic Overview

This half-term we will be finding out about a variety of different animals across the world in rich cross curricular lessons. (English, science, music). This will also link with our DT work of making pop up books.
