- How is the Bayeux tapestry created?
- The Bayeux Tapestry gives an account of the Norman invasion of England and the Battle of Hastings. The battle happened in 1066.
- The tapestry is embroidered in wool on linen. It is 70 metres long and 50 centimetres high. No one is exactly sure who made it, although most historians agree it was made in England in the 11th century.








Running Stitch

Back stitch—sewing stitches in which stitches are made backward to the general direction of sewing.

Cross stitch - X-shaped stitches in a tiled, rasterlike pattern are used to form a picture **Prototypes** - a first or preliminary version of a product from which other forms are developed. **Computer Aided Design**— the use of computers to aid in the creation, modification, analysis, or optimization of a design
