1. Who is Georgia O'Keeffe?

Georgia O'Keeffe was an **American** artist who painted **nature** in a way that **showed** how it **made** her feel.

She is **best known** for her **paintings** of **flowers** and **desert landscapes**.

She played an important part in the **development** of **modern art** in **America**, becoming the **first female painter** to gain **respect** in **New York's art world** in the 1920s.



2. What colour does Georgia O'Keeffe use in her painting?

She would often use **bright blues, yellows, greens, reds, and purples**. Georgia O'Keeffe uses colours in her artwork that sit next to each other on the colour wheel and look great together.

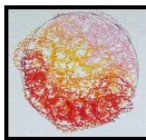

Key Vocabulary

Colour	The perceived hue of an object by which it reflects or emits light.
Shades of Colour	Shade is a hue or mixture of pure colours to which only black is added.
Cartridge Paper	Cartridge paper is a type of high-quality heavy paper used for illustration and drawing
Texture	Refers to surface characteristics and appearance - use smooth, rough, soft or hard.
