**City**- huge "urban" place, with lots of tall buildings very close together and millions of people live there.

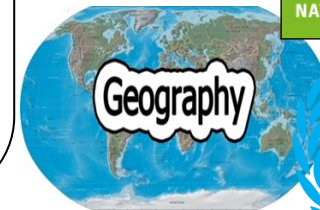
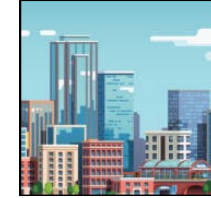
**Towns**- smaller than cities with a less people but bigger than a village.
