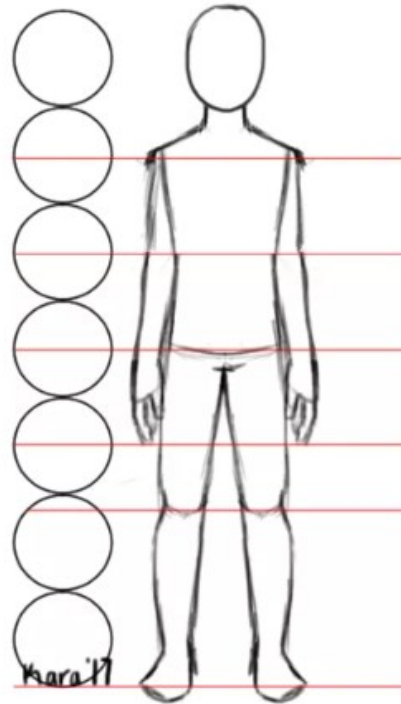
1. Who is Richard Wawro?

- 1952-2006
- A Scottish landscape artist
- Used the medium of wax oil crayons (over 4000 drawings).
- He was non-verbal and blind and had characteristics of autism.



2. What is proportional drawing?

1. Draw 7 circles about the same size.
2. Draw an oval to make the head.
3. Halfway down the second circle from the top, add a horizontal line. This is where the shoulder stops.
4. Halfway down the third circle, draw another horizontal line. This is where the waist will be.
5. Halfway down the fourth circle end the body.
6. Halfway down the fifth circle, end the fingertips.
7. Just past the top of the sixth circle, end the knees.
8. Finish the bottom of the feet where the last circle ends.
