

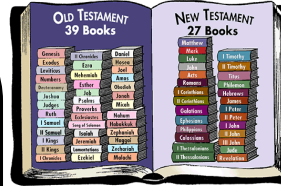


What is the significance of the Bible to Christians?

The bible is written chronological order.

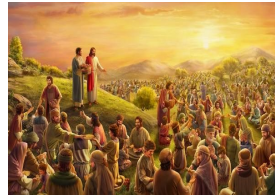


3 What is the relevance of the Bible story 'Jesus in the temple/gets lost teach Christians about how to live their lives

4. What is the relevance of the Bible story 'Feeding the 5000' to our lives?

A Gospel story of Jesus feeding the 5,000. A young boy's lunch of loaves and fishes is blessed by Jesus and miraculously feeds a large crowd of people that have gathered. The miracle of feeding the 5,000 symbolizes God's provision and the need for trust in Him. Christians are encouraged to recognize their blessings and trust in God's sufficiency for their lives.



2. What is the relevance of the Bible story 'Crossing the Red Sea' to our lives?

When the Israelites reached the Red Sea Moses stretched out his hand and the waters divided, allowing his followers safe passage. The Egyptians followed them but God again commanded Moses to stretch out his hand and the sea engulfed the army. This story is recounted in the Old Testament

Each story gives guidance on how to live your life as a Christian through stories of extraordinary circumstances. Christians need to trust in God and he will provide what they need.
