- Sing in unison with the rest of the team.

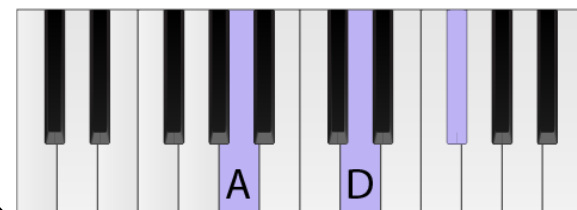
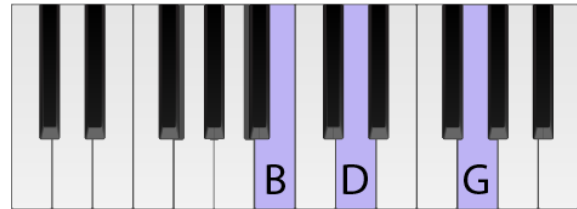
Applying Past knowledge

Use your evaluation of these to help you be successful.

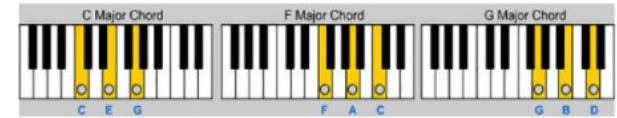
2. What is a chord?

- A chord is a group of notes played at the same time.
- Chords are usually made up of two or three notes.



3. Can I play a chord progression?

- A chord progression is a series of chords played one after the other.
- A chord progression is often used to accompany the melody.



3. Can I sing and play in time with accuracy and awareness of my part in the group?

- Stay in time with the music. Listen to the pulse.
- Play the chord progression in time with the music.
- Sing the song with fluency and accuracy in time with the chord progression.
