

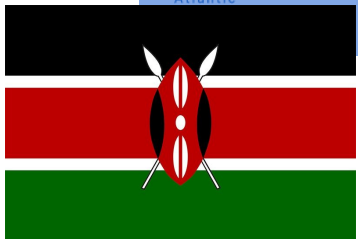
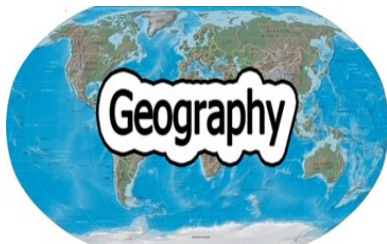

1. Where is Kenya?

- **Climate**—long-term pattern of weather for a particular area .
- **Weather**—the day to day condition of the atmosphere.
- **Equator**— an imaginary circle around the world. It divides the world into two equal parts- the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere.
- **Temperate**— a region or climate characterised by mild temperatures .



4 and 5. What are the physical and human features in Nairobi and how are they similar to London?

- **Physical geography**— natural features such as mountains, rivers, deserts and oceans.
- **Human geography** — built by people such as houses and roads.
