**Offspring-** an animal's young

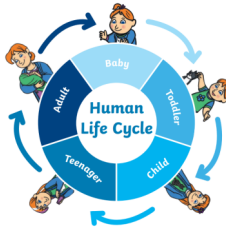
**Life cycle-** a life cycle is a series of stages a living thing goes through during its life

### 2. Is that my offspring?

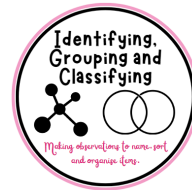
Off spring are an animals young.

A foal is a baby horse.

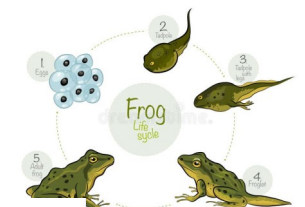
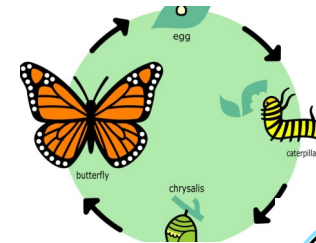
A piglet is a baby pig.
