Pitch is how high and low a sound is.

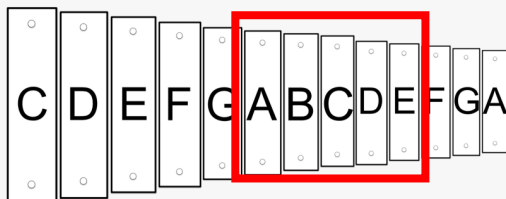
3. Can we use rhythm, pitch and dynamics to represent light and dark at Stonehenge?
