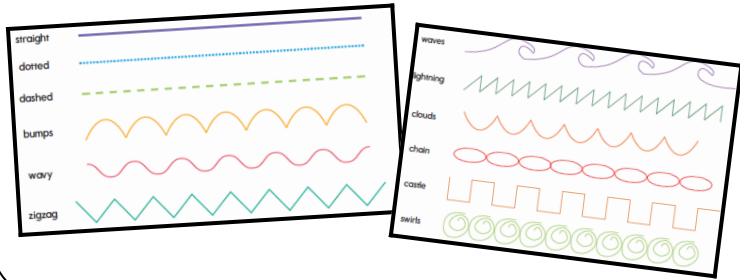




How can I use line and pattern to create a pencil drawing?

Line is a mark that is longer than it is wide. Lines can be horizontal, vertical, diagonal, curved and change directions.

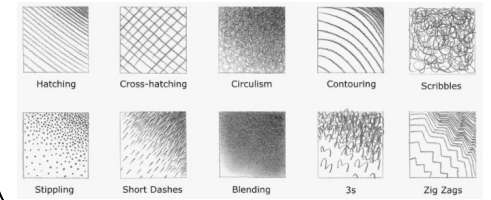

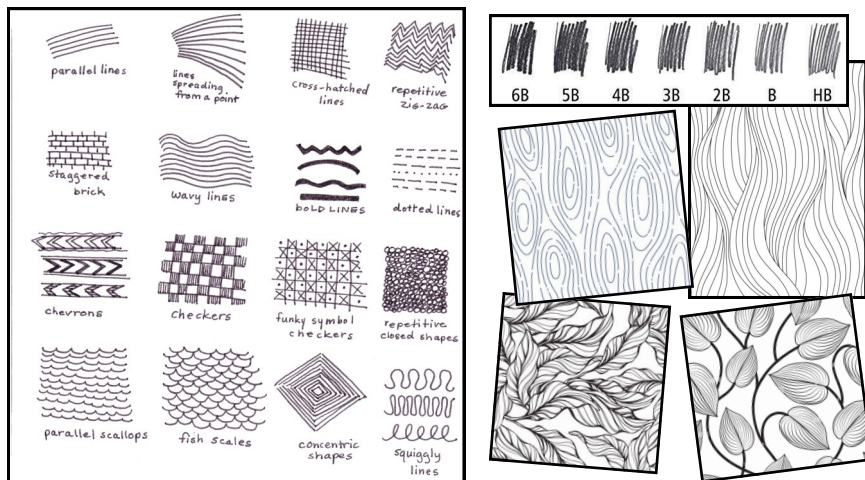


4. How can I add line and tone using a fine liner
