



## How can I use acrylic paint to create colour and texture?

### 1. Who is Vincent Van Gogh?

Vincent Willem van Gogh was a Dutch painter

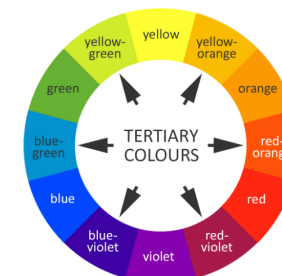
He painted lots of landscapes, but also painted portraits and still life.

He mostly used oil paints, but also worked with watercolours, and other materials.



### 3. How do I make tertiary colours?

A tertiary colour is made by mixing equal amounts of a primary colour and a secondary colour together.



### 2 How do I apply acrylic paint?

Acrylic paint is thicker than other paint so can be used to create texture.

- Use different parts of the brush.
- Use different brush sizes.

### Key Vocabulary

- Impasto** Using thickly textured paints that often stick out of the canvas.
- Paint Pallets** A selection of colours to choose from.
- Acrylic Paint** Acrylic paint is *water-based fast-drying paint*
- Canvas** a strong paper used for painting with acrylic
- Tint** lightening a colour by adding white.
- Tinge** A slight amount of something; used by adding shade or colour.
