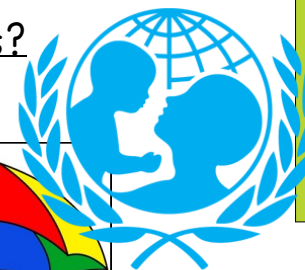




# A Change Over Time

2. Why do religions have festivals and what are the common ways in which we celebrate?

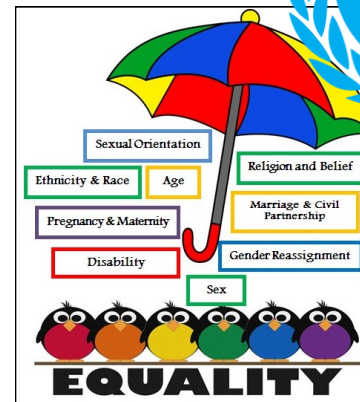
We will understand why we celebrate different festivals and discover similarities between them. E.g. light, food, cards, gifts etc.

We will understand that clothes help us to: express ourselves, identify or connect with a community, and can also be a way of showing respect.

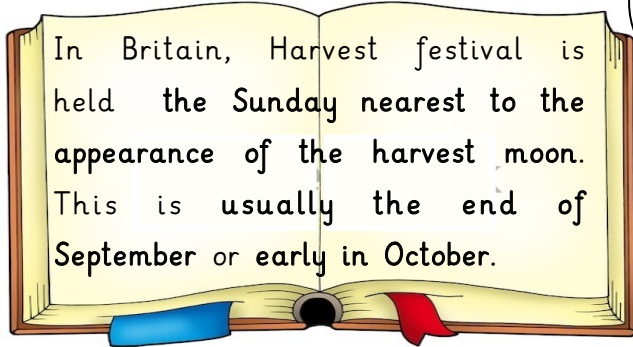
4. What is the Harvest festival and why do Christians celebrate it?
