

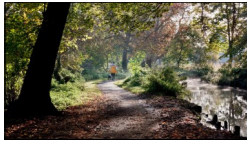


# Carnival of Animals

1. What are human and physical features?

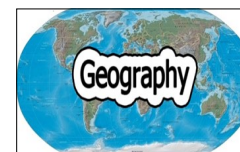
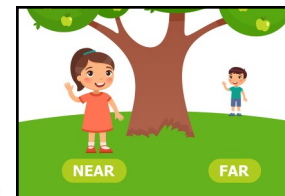
