How do religious people show they belong to a community?

1. What does it mean to belong?

Belonging means to feel part of something. You can belong to different groups like a: family, school, club, community, faith group etc.

2. How do we show we belong?

Children will understand some communities require us to wear uniforms/ badges or have special clothes to show we belong. E.g. uniforms or specific clothes (school, police, nurses, religious clothing).

3. How do we welcome someone new ?

We will talk about different ways to make others feel welcome, e.g. invite them to join in with your play, smile at them, but they can also make a pledge or promise to their community.

4. What does faith mean?

Faith is the belief and trust in, and loyalty to, their God.

5. What are the major religions of the world?

They are Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Sikhism and Judaism.



5. How do religious people show they belong to a community?

Religious people wear special clothes. E.g. Christians wear a cross, Jewish men wear a kippah, Muslim women wear hijabs.
