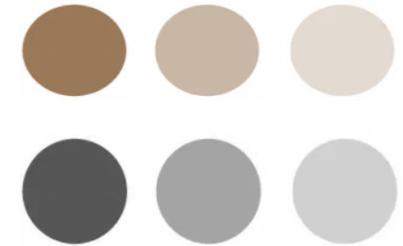




A Step in Time



How can we make tints of primary colours to create a painting in the style of William Morris?



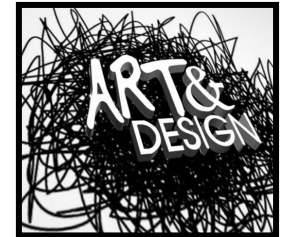
1. Who is William Morris?

William Morris was born in 1834. He was an **artist** who made lots of his art in a studio in **Merton Abbey Mills**. He is very famous and people still love his work today.

2. What are the primary colours?

The three primary colours are basic colours that can be mixed together to produce other colours.

They are: **red**, **yellow**, **blue**.



3. How can I create tints of the primary colours?

Tints are lighter colours that are made by **mixing a colour with white**. For example, pink is a tint of red, and light blue is a tint of blue.

4. How can I create a William Morris picture?

We will create our own pictures in the style of William Morris. We will be adding white paint to primary colours to create tints.



Key vocabulary

primary colours - These are red, yellow and blue and can not be made.

tint - In painting, a colour plus white.
