

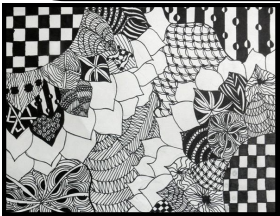


# Very Victorian Values

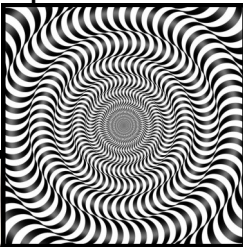
## How can we make patterns using line?

1. Who was Bridget Riley? What do all her pieces have in common?

- Bridget Riley is an English artist and painter.
- She uses lines and pattern and often does this in black and white.
- She uses geometric patterns (series of shapes) and often creates optical illusions.

2. What different lines can I make?

We can create different types of lines like: curved, straight, zig zag, horizontal, vertical, diagonal., jagged etc.

3. What is the difference between HB and 4B?

- We can use different types of pencils for different types of lines/ thicknesses.
- A HB pencil is harder and black. This is good for sketching.
- A 4 HB is softer and is better for shading.

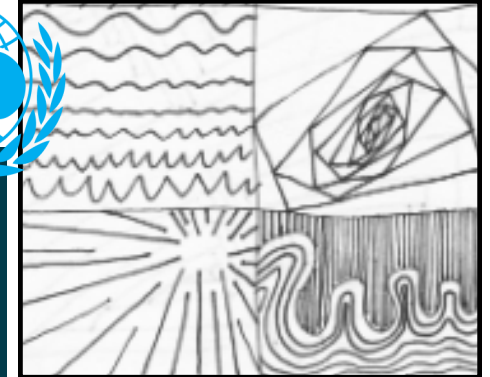
**Pattern** – objects or designs that are repeated

**Line** – a long mark or stroke

**Straight** – extending in one direction only

**Curved** – having a rounded or smoothly bending line.

**Length** – the measurement or extent of something from end to end.
