Teach Our phoneme today is:

/oa/

These words include five ways of writing the code for the /oa/ phoneme (sound). The 'oe' grapheme is less common but it appears when 'es' is added to some words ending with the letter 'o' to form the plural words such as 'tomatoes', 'potatoes', 'mangoes', 'echoes', 'dominoes', 'tornadoes' and 'heroes'.
