Nursery Summer Term Visits & Activities

Over this coming term we have organised two very special events for the children in Nursery to help enhance their learning. We are very excited and hope you will be too.

Morden Hall Park

We are very lucky to be visiting Morden Hall Park this term to learn all about the insects and their habitats. We will go on a mini-beast hunt and run through the field to see what we can catch! This trip will take place within the school day and all children will need a packed lunch on this day. We will be walking to and from the park and will need parent helpers to assist. If weather allows we will have a picnic at Morden Hall Park either before the activities or after.

Wednesday 3rd May AM Nursery: 10-11.30am
Please can children be dropped to Nursery at the usual time but please collect from Morden Hall Park at 11.30am.

Wednesday 3rd May PM Nursery: 12.30-2.00pm
Please can children <u>be dropped off at Morden Hall Park at 12.30pm</u> and they will be collected at the usual time from school.

The children will be walked to or from the park (dependent on the session your child attends) by members of staff. We will also require Parental help for this trip to accompany us there and/or back (dependent on the session your child attends) and supervise a small group during the activities. Please let member of staff know if you can support us on this day. If you do not wish your child to participate in this trip then please be advised that there will be **no Nursery** on this day. Consent for the trip is made via Parent Pay.

If your child attends Little Catapillars then **we will need verbal confirmation** that you wish staff to walk them to the Park after their little Catarpillars session, as well as the payment being made on ParentPay, otherwise we will assume they are not attending the trip.

For the children who attend Nursery for the full day, they will attend in the trip in morning and will return to school to have lunch and complete their day.

Hobbledown Family Day

We are very excited to announce that the chosen venue for our family trip will be Hobbledown - A Mystical Adventure! This is a truly amazing day out where we invite **the children and their families** to join us in exploring all the attractions that are a part of Hobbledown.
