Year 2 Summer Term Visits & Activities

As part of our Under the Sea topic, we have arranged a visit to the BFI IMAX cinema on Friday 9th June 2017.

Under the Sea 3D, a new IMAX® 3D adventure, transports moviegoers to some of the most exotic and isolated undersea locations on Earth, including Southern Australia, New Guinea and others in the Indo-Pacific region, allowing them to experience face-to-face encounters with some of the most mysterious and stunning creatures of the sea. It offers a uniquely inspirational and entertaining way to explore the beauty and natural wonder of the oceans, as well as the impact of global climate change. In IMAX 3D, the images will leap off the screen and float around the theatre, putting the audience in the movie.

We will be travelling by tube from school to Waterloo, where the IMAX is located within a short walk. The children will need to bring a packed lunch to school on this day, in their Hillcross Rucksack which should include a disposable water bottle (no glass bottles). Please note that part of the days experiences we will be travelling outside so all children will need to bring a warm or waterproof coat depending on the weather.

There will be a cost of $\underline{\textbf{£5.50}}$ for this visit. This includes travel to and from the palace by tube; admission into the cinema. You are invited to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of your child taking part in the educational visit as detailed above. We confirm that the contribution represents our estimate of the costs shared equally amongst all pupils. No child will be excluded from the visit through an inability to pay, but if there are insufficient contributions then the visit may have to be **cancelled**.

All contributions and permissions must be given via ParentPay by Monday 22nd May.

As we will be leaving promptly, all children will need to be school **by 8.45am** and will be collected by their class teachers from their classrooms. We aim to return to school by 3.00 pm. We will need quite a few parent volunteers to accompany us on the trip for the day otherwise we will be unable to go. If you are interested, please speak to your child's class teacher. Please note you will require a DBS (previously CRB) or List 99 check before the day of the visit so we will need to know as soon as possible.

We look forward to an exciting, enjoyable and informative trip.
