

3. You can make a **melody** (a **tune**) by putting different pitches in a sequence.

Melodies can move by leaps (big jumps between pitches) or by step (pitches that are next to each other).



Key words

pitch—how high or low a sound is
dynamics—how loud or soft (quiet)
the music is

notes—different pitches in music. Named with letters from A—G

melody (tune)—a sequence of pitches / notes.
