

2. What is a mammal? Mammals include humans and all other animals that are: **warm-blooded**. have hair and give birth to live babies.

3. What is a bird?

Birds are **warm-blooded** animals that have; feathers, wings and beaks. All birds lay eqqs.

4. What is a fish? Fish live underwater and Nhave **gills,** that allow them to breathe. All fish have scales.

5. <u>What is an reptile?</u> Reptiles are **cold-blooded** animals that have dry, scaly skin. Most of them lay eqqs. Crocodiles, snakes, lizards and turtles are all reptiles.

6. <u>What is an amphibian?</u> Amphibians are cold-blooded animals that don't have scales. They live part of their lives in water and part on

land.
