1. What is an animal and what animals can we find around school?

Animals are living things. Like plants, animals need food and water to live. There are 5 main types of animals: mammal, bird, fish, reptile and amphibian.

2. What is a mammal?

Mammals include humans and all other animals that are: warm-blooded, have hair and give birth to live babies.

3. What is a bird?

4. What is a fish?

Fish live underwater and have gills, that allow them to breathe. All fish have scales.

5. What is an reptile?

Reptiles are cold-blooded animals that have dry, scaly skin. Most of them lay eggs. Crocodiles, snakes, lizards and turtles are all reptiles.

6. What is an amphibian?

Amphibians are cold-blooded animals that don't have scales. They live part of their lives in water and part on land.
