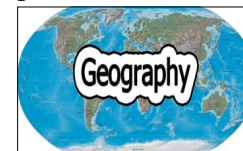




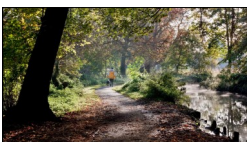
Carnival of Animals
