



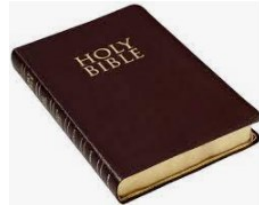
Journey Over Europe: *Who Do Christians Believe Jesus is?*

1. Who was Jesus?

Son of God in Roman Times—Christians believe that God came to earth in human form and shared the human experience.



Key vocabulary

Jesus	the Jewish religious teacher whose life, death, and resurrection
Baptism	the Christian religious rite of sprinkling water on to a person's forehead or of immersing them in water
Disciples	a personal follower of Christ during his life, especially one of the twelve Apostles.
Tempta-	the desire to do something, especially something
Kingdom of God	one of the key elements of the teachings of Jesus in the New Testament.
Parables	a simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson, as told by Jesus in the Gospels.
Miracles	an extraordinary and welcome event that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws
Gospels	the teaching or revelation of Christ.
Ministry	the work or vocation of a minister of religion.

2. What was the purpose of Jesus' ministry?

This is the reason that Jesus came to the earth: to save his people from their sins by his life, death and resurrection. Some key events are:

Saving people from sin

What did Jesus do?

He helps Zacchaeus to become a better person by giving him a second chance. This makes Zacchaeus put right all his bad actions.

Being a messenger

What did Jesus do?

Jesus teaches people how to behave correctly.

Performing miracles

What did Jesus do?

Turned water into wine at the wedding feast.

Changing society

What did Jesus do?

He defies the laws of the Sabbath to help heal a man. He argues with the Pharisees that laws can be broken if it helps someone. They begin to plot how to get rid of him.

3. What is the message behind the parable of 'the Prodigal Son'?

-The father forgives his son after he has been away from home.
-This links to God waiting for human to realise what they have done wrong and welcomes them back when they ask for forgiveness.
