



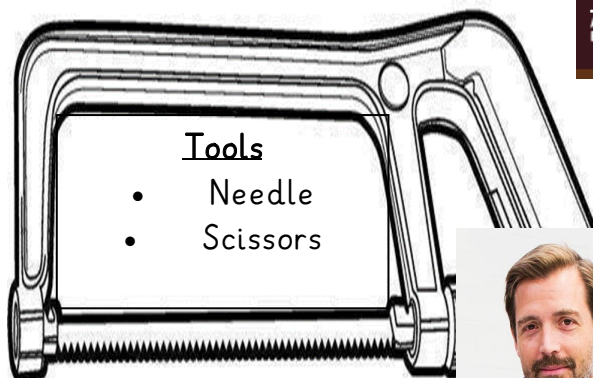
## Key Vocabulary

**Running stitch**—The basic stitch used in sewing. The stitch is worked by passing the needle in and out of the fabric at a regular distance

**Joining**—link/combining things together

**Needle**—a tool we use to join fabric together

**Thread**—we thread the 'yarn' through the needle

How do we join fabric?  
How can I make a hand puppet?

### 1. How can I join my material together?

There are many different ways to join fabric pieces together but which is the best? We are going to investigate different ways to join material e.g. glue, sellotape, blu-tac, and needle and thread. Then we will decide which was the most effective.



### 3. What is the purpose of a puppet?

A puppet is a movable model of a person or animal that is typically moved either by strings controlled from above or by a hand inside it. Puppets can be used as a toy or to perform puppet shows.
